Summary of 2022 Efforts

In 2022, Maya's Hope faced unprecedented challenges in supporting orphanages in Ukraine due to war. It had severe repercussions for the children in many institutions, especially those located in areas at the front line of the war in eastern Ukraine. As a result of the ongoing hostilities, children from these institutions were forced to evacuate to safer locations, including a dozen institutions within the European Union.

Maya's Hope continued to support orphaned children who remained in the country, particularly in Western Ukraine. Our focus remained on providing essential aid and support to those children who continued to face hardships and uncertainties due to the ongoing conflict.

Due to the war, numerous children residing in institutions were forced to seek shelter in basements amid bombardments, facing dire conditions without access to electricity or running water.

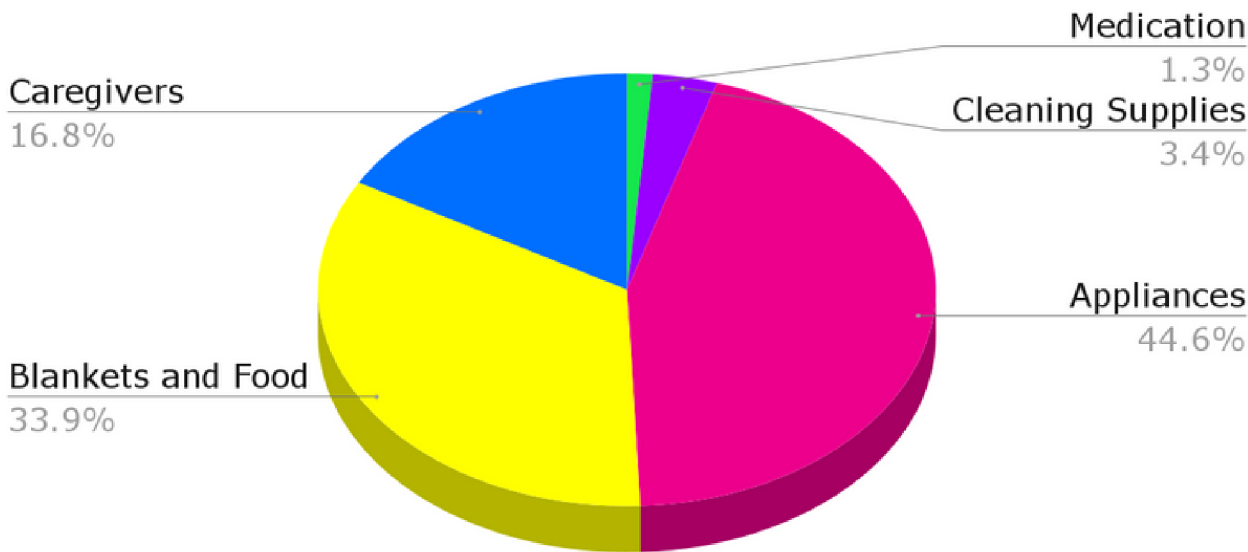


Summary of 2022 Efforts

In 2022, Maya's Hope helped 468 orphans in Ukraine's orphanages.

Through thoughtful gifts from our corporate partners and individual donors, we provided critical resources, including medication, cleaning supplies, non-perishable food, warm blankets, and essential appliances, ensuring the well-being of these children. Our efforts aimed to create a nurturing environment and improve their living conditions.

We collaborated closely with local partners and institutions in Western Ukraine to identify the most pressing needs and ensure that the support provided was tailored to meet the specific requirements of the children.



Cleaning Supplies

This initiative focused on providing essential cleaning supplies to maintain cleanliness, sanitation, and overall well-being within the orphanage premises.



Appliances

This project aimed to enhance the living conditions of 150 children residing in the orphanage by providing essential appliances. These appliances, including electric ranges, fridges, washer and dryer, and other necessary equipment, are crucial for creating a comfortable and functional living environment for the children.



Blankets and Food

As the children in the orphanage faced the approaching winter in a war-torn country, we provided warm blankets and non-perishable food supplies to address the challenges posed by harsh weather conditions and frequent power outages. In navigating and adjusting to difficult circumstances, we sought to create a safe and nurturing environment for the children, ensuring their well-being during this challenging period.



Caregivers

Maya's Hope funded caregivers for 18 children with disabilities living in a family-type children's home. This project aimed to provide these vulnerable children with specialized care, attention, and support tailored to their unique needs.



Summary of 2023 Expansion

In 2023, Maya's Hope has helped 103 more orphans in Ukraine's orphanages.

In 2023, we expanded our impact by adding another orphanage in Western Ukraine to our patronage. This move allowed us to extend support to 103 additional children in need. With the continued generosity of our donors, we provided essential aid, including food, hygiene items, vitamins, stationery, as well as clothes and shoes.
